

## Practising Health Professional Capacity Building SEED Grants

This Program will provide two seeding grants at \$10,000 each to support research and engagement, translation engagement and capacity building among clinically active health professionals, providing research secondments. This will allow clinically active researchers to have protected time and obtain seed funding for a 12-month project commencing before 30 April 2023.

### Application Form:

Applicants must be a researcher and clinically active health professional (working clinically at least one day a week or having more than 10 years' experience as an active clinician). Clinicians should have a PhD and be no more than 10 years post PhD (taking into account career disruptions). They must work with a member of the CRE HiPP investigator team – a chief investigator or an associate investigator.
